## SZapp Trial run

We have had a trial run with the PSSA sport notes using the school app to do electronic notes. Thank you to everyone for giving it a try. We are hoping you have found it convenient.

**In preparation for next term we are asking that everyone has SZapp installed on their phone.**


### What SZapp can be used for:

- Send absence notifications when your child is away
- Change of details if you change address/ email or phone number
- School calendar listing all events by type so you can filter to what type of event you want to see.
- School Newsletters
- Direct Link to Camp Australia
- Direct link to Munch Monitor
- Direct link to school website
- Direct link to the P&C section of school website

### A few things to remember when using the app:


- Electronic notes will come to you via a message in your feed. Simply click on **“Feed”** to see all messages
  - **Click the message to open it completely** as there is often important information regarding the note.
- Permission notes will no longer be in the notes and forms section of the website. This will only be used for information notes **not** requiring permission.
- Go into **“Manage”** to select the groups you want to be connected to. Ie your child year group, music, dance etc.


**Apple devices:**

3. Download and install SZapp.




**Android devices:**

3. Download and install SZapp.





# Urgent Canteen Meeting Notification- All families please read

To all Parents and Carers,

Our wonderful canteen has been struggling for volunteers which has forced it to close on certain days this year. Our P&C are looking to open a discussion with our parent community before making a decision on its operation for 2020. There is a real possibility that in 2020 our canteen will close as it has proven unsustainable in its current form.

We would like to invite any parents, grandparents and carers who have suggestions, who use the canteen, who may have connections with third party providers and who volunteer in our canteen to join us on Saturday 2 November at 9.30am for an hour meeting to discuss options for canteen. These involve discussion around current volunteerism, new committee members and outsourcing to a third party. We will also discuss the results of the recent survey which was conducted in relation to the canteen.

We invite everyone to come along, and children welcome to bring a ball to kick around on the oval while we meet.

## Headlines

- The majority of work needed to run the canteen is being done by 2 people being paid a maximum of 12 hours a week. This is insufficient.
- Our canteen is most importantly a service to our students and busy families. If we make a profit to donate to the school it is a bonus.
- Previous years have seen over \$20,000 donated back to the school but this year the canteen is battling to break even.
- Our canteen committee members are currently zero.
- We are regularly struggling to fill the shifts in the canteen, so as of term 4 we will only be able to open 2 days a week. This may need to be cut further.

Should a canteen committee be the best option, please note that we currently have no one on the canteen committee at all and all positions are vacant. Below is a summary of the roles available. We would require a minimum of 4 people to volunteer for this committee to make it a viable option. We are well aware that 1 person performing all roles in the canteen is too big a task for parents who are already pressed for time. Ideally 6-8 people would ensure bite size responsibilities and smooth operation. Dads make a wonderful addition to the committee and please note many of the roles can be done outside of school / business hours.

### CANTEEN CONVENER

Oversee the running of the Canteen operations, Canteen Volunteers. Reports to the P&C Executive. Oversee the ordering of food and implementation of canteen procedures / systems. Responsible for the OH&S and Food Safety standards as well as Healthy Food. (Duties will need some time during School hours, but not all – estimate 8 hours per month)

### CANTEEN TREASURER

Financial Management of the Canteen. Approval of Payment of accounts to our external accounts team, reporting, review of expenditure and canteen pricing. (Duties can be performed out of school hours – estimate 4 hours per month)

### EVENTS CONVENER

Coordinates the special events which canteen operates such as Fathers Day, Grandfriend day and special days for the students such as Hot Dog Day. (Ad hoc duties and flexible around your availability to arrange, can be mainly done out of School hours. Est 4-6 hours a term)

### PURCHASING OFFICER (can be a shared role)

Weekly management of ordering from our established suppliers and fresh food ordering for delivery. (Duties can be performed out of school hours, however there is a need to physically come into the canteen. Has previously been done on weekends – estimate 1-2 hours per week and can be a shared role)

### MUNCH MONITOR MANAGER

Regular updating of our Munch monitor with new items. (At this stage needs to be carried out in the Canteen, estimate 1 hour a week)

### CANTEEN COMMITTEE MEMBERS

To assist with daily operations, cooking, roster coordination. (Roles dependent on above roles and duties. Mainly during school hours. Roster coordination can be done from home, not time specific).
