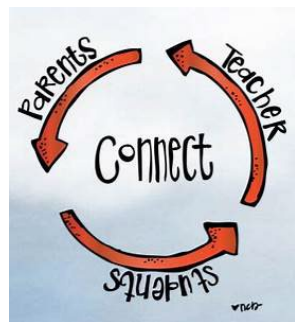

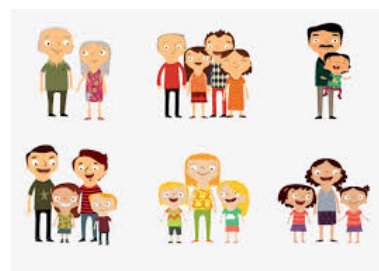

Student Wellbeing

A student in our school is currently receiving treatment which results in a lowered immune system, which means, the student is more prone to getting ill from infections. As the student is not contagious but has a chronic illness, it is important he/she participates actively in the day to day school program without any major limitations. A major concern is that if this student develops measles, chickenpox,

whooping cough or influenza, he/she could become seriously ill. I seek your cooperation in preventing this situation.

If your child has or may have chickenpox or measles, I would ask that you please:

Do not send them to school.

Notify the Office and Principal immediately.

Take them to your GP or medical centre to confirm the diagnosis immediately.

Sport in Schools Australia

Having fun, feeling good about oneself and being well are things we all seek for our children.

One role of physical education within the school curriculum is to help all children attain and enjoy optimum health. This involves the development of the knowledge, skills, understanding

and motivation required for children to seek health and physical competence through life long involvement in activity.

As part of our PDHPE program Sport in Schools Australia will run a fortnightly program focussing on developing students:

- motor skills
- physical activities of locomotion,
- throwing and launching,
- tracking and catching,
- hitting & striking,
- balance and core stability.

The cost of this program will be on the Term One School Account.



Student Workbooks and Text Books

Students have now received their text books and class exercise books. Teachers have asked for exercise books to be covered in contact or plastic to help books survive the wear and tear of school usage. Text books do not need to be contacted. Thank you to the many families who have paid for their child's text books. Reminder emails have been sent to families who have not yet paid for text books. Please attend to this as a matter of urgency.

Parent/Carer Volunteer requirements

Helping out at school is a great way to get involved in your child's education and to get to know the school staff and other parents.

All volunteers who are working with our students, whether within classrooms, around the school, on an excursion or at a sporting event are required to complete an **appendix 5 Declaration for volunteers** and show 100 points proof of identity (documents which may be provided are included with the form). Once completed, you need to bring the form and the original proof of identity documents to the office for verification. Once these are sighted they will be returned to you. You may then work with the children.

(The simplest 100 points is Passport or birth cert and a drivers licence). This is a one off declaration that will last for the whole time your child attends Terrey Hills Public.

Appendix 5 Declaration for volunteers form is attached with the newsletter, available at the office OR can be downloaded from the Notes section on the Terrey Hills website accessible via SZapp. All volunteers will be required



Student Health Needs

Please ensure the school is aware of any medical needs your child may have. It is the responsibility of parents to provide updated health plans, action plans and medicine to the school and this is tied to your child's enrolment. Please note, Anaphylaxis Action Plans need to be in colour, on the most recent form provided by ASCIA (currently 2020). ASCIA plans and asthma plans are required every 12 months so must be up to date. ASCIA forms and Health Care Plan Forms are available on the school website under "Notes".

Thank you to parents who have already visited the office with an updated Health Plan and Action Plan. Please also ensure that your child's medication is current.

If you have not yet visited the office to provide your child's health care plan, action plan and to check that your child's medication is current, please do so as soon as possible.



Scripture

Students in Years 1 – 6 will be placed in the same Scripture faith attended last year, unless parents request for their child to change groups through email by Monday 17th February.

Please only email if you are requesting a change and place Scripture Request in the subject line. terreyhill-p.school@det.nsw.edu.au

Scripture options at Terrey Hills include Catholic, Protestant or Non-Scripture. The NSW Department of Education does not allow us to teach students during the allocated 30 minute Scripture time each Tuesday. Students who opt out of Special Religious Education (SRE), otherwise known as Scripture, read or complete a quiet, independent activity supervised by staff.

Changing Scripture groups

We are sometimes asked whether students can change scripture groups each term. Students are placed in a class for the year. It is not an option to experience different scripture groups in a school year, however, parents can choose a different group the following year. Thank you for your understanding.



Ethics Classes

2019 was the first year Ethics classes were offered for children in Years 2 and 3 not attending Scripture. Ethics classes aim to help children develop the skills of critical thinking and moral reasoning. Students learn to view issues from different angles, carefully listen to what others have to

say, respectfully disagree if their opinion differs and to be able to reasonably support their viewpoint. The content is approved by the Department of Education is age appropriate and topics vary widely. Classes are facilitated by a trained ethics volunteer teacher who receives full training through online modules and a comprehensive 2 day workshop.

For the program to be extended to other stages, we will need more volunteers in 2020. Grandparents and other members of your family and friends' network might also be interested in volunteering, so please speak to them about volunteering if you believe they are suitable. Congratulations to Holly of class 4R for her responses to how she would like her classmates, teacher, classroom and the school to be.

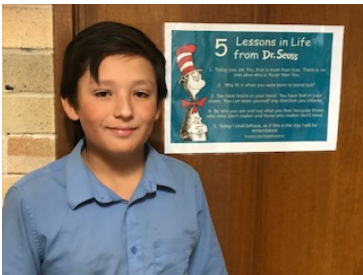

SZapp – School app

It is imperative that all parents have the school app installed on their phone. This app is used to communicate to parents day to day events and last minute changes to events. It will also be used in emergency situations.

All notes for school excursions requiring permission are also distributed via the app and parents reply using the app reducing the need for paper notes.

What SZapp can be used for:

- Receiving notifications from the school
- Send absence notifications when your child is away
- Change of details if you change address/ email or phone number
- School calendar listing all events by type so you can filter to what type of event you want to see.
- School Newsletters
- Direct Link to Camp Australia
- Direct link to Munch Monitor
- Direct link to school website
- Direct link to the P&C section of school website

A few things to remember when using the app:

- **Go into “Manage” to select the groups you want to be connected to. Ie your child year group, music, dance etc. This needs to be done at the beginning of every year as your child moves year groups.**
- Electronic notes will come to you via a message in your feed. Simply click on **“Feed”** to see all messages
- **Click the message to open it completely** as there is often important information regarding the note. Complete the permission section and submit.
- Permission notes will no longer be in the notes and forms section of the website. This will only be used for information notes **not** requiring permission.
