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## Stage-based Classes

Stage-based, or multi-age, classes occur in schools for a number of reasons.

All classes, whether a single year level or stage-based class group, have children with diverse learning needs and abilities.

In any class, there will be teaching and learning that occurs as a whole class, in small groups and at an individual level.

Research tells us that 'high quality teaching and learning is the key to a successful learning environment in any classroom, not the structure or makeup of the class. There is no evidence that student learning may be hindered in a composite class'.

#### Differentiation

Teachers are trained in differentiating the curriculum to meet the varying abilities of their students

#### Here are some strategies that we use:

- Planning open-ended tasks
- Planning tasks that allow for different entry points
- Providing targeted small group and individual instruction
- Setting individual goals
